Master's in **International Relations**

Building on the knowledge acquired in the first semester, in the second semester students take a pathway specialty allowing them to tailor their education according to their individual interests within the various subfields of international relations.

The 60 ECTS Master's degree is fully accredited and jointly awarded by three renowned Barcelona universities: the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona, the Universitat de Barcelona and the Universitat Pompeu Fabra Barcelona.

The degree can be studied exclusively in English or also in a bilingual option, which is offered either full-time (1 year) or part-time (2 years). The syllabus combines compulsory courses on the politics and economics of international relations with a wide range of electives that provides a personalized degree reflecting each student's individual interests. Internships are also available, as are semester exchanges to universities in over 20 countries:

ADMISSIONS

All students must be proficient in English, and those who choose the bilingual track will also have to submit proof of their proficiency in Spanish.

The tuition fee for the Master's in International Relations is €12,540 (60 ECTS)
